To treat underprivileged children suffering from Congenital Heart Defects and helping them to lead a normal life.


OVERVIEW FY22-23

73 children were treated out of which majority were suffering from the following:

- Ventricular Septal Defect
- Atrial Septal Defect
- Patent Ductus Arteriosus
- ASD Closure Surgery













Advocacy & Training on Safe Usage & Spraying of Agro Chemicals

PI Foundation in collaboration with the Roots Foundation has been implementing this project in Punjab & Haryana to create awareness about the effective application of Agro Chemicals in their farms / crops.

OBJECTIVE

- To create advocacy, awareness & training of farmers and applicators on the safe usage and spraying of Agro Chemicals.
- Entrepreneurship development among farmers by giving them the opportunity to lease out the equipment and transfer knowledge to other farmers.

Operation Nalla Tamara Purugu:

An Integrated Approach for Chilli Black Thrips Management

'Operation Nalla Tamara Purugu' launched by PI Foundation and being implemented by SABC to combat invasive black thrips in chilli (locally known as Nalla Tamara Purugu) in the states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. The project was launched in September 2022 and is ongoing at the ground level.

OBJECTIVE

- To create awareness and demonstrations about IPM & INM for effective management of black thrips after identification of chilli clusters.
- Create awareness about innovative technologies for pest management.













- The operation covered: 2000+ chilli farmers
- Distributed multicolored sticky straps to chilli farmers: 3300
- Distribution of safety kits: 700
- Drone-based Spray demonstrations conducted in chilli fields: 54 acres
- Total number of trainings conducted: 9















Women Empowerment through improved access to credit and livelihood initiatives

ASMITA project launched by PI Foundation and being implemented by Aatapi Foundation in 20 villages of Jambusar and Panoli area.



OBJECTIVE

- To strengthen the Self Help Groups (SHGs) by financial inclusion & cluster meetings.
- To impart skill trainings to women in order to create income generation activity.
- To create literacy and awareness about women's rights, entitlements, health & finances for better access.









SHG Savings & Finances:

Total 206 SHGs and 2911 women in 20 villages of Jambusar & Panoli

Particulars	Amount
Total savings done by 206 SHGs	₹41 lacs
Total 341 members received loans through various financial linkages	₹50 lacs
Total loans received by 190 members of joint liability groups	₹50 lacs

- Trainings, Skill Development & Income Generation:
 - Total 350+ women trained in capacity building and income generation activities
 - Total 143 members of SHGs generated ₹5.5 lacs through income generating activities.
- Skills imparted were in jewellery making, rakhi making, candle and paper bag making
- Capacity building trainings were conducted in Financial Literacy, Record keeping, Legal Literacy training













Improved Agriculture and Inclusive Dairy Value Chain Promotion

PI Foundation along with its implementing partner CARE India is implementing this project in 59 villages of Jambusar block of Bharuch district.

OBJECTIVE

- To strengthen community-based cluster level federations to assume intermediary services for better access to finance, various schemes, market linkages and value chain
- To improve Women Smallholder & Workers (WSW) alternate income from small and micro enterprise activities, agriculture and dairy value chain with adoption of improved package of practices in agriculture and allied activities
- To promote responsive, positive and an enabling attitude towards WSW by service providers, value chain actors and market institutions









The project has been working with 3444 women smallholders through 300 SHGs, 6 cluster-level federations and 1 block-level federation.

Trainings & Skill Development



- Average Income generated per member by 286 members: ₹21,000 p.a.
- 108 women entrepreneurs were supported with sign boards for improving visibility and awareness at village level



Digitalised Milk Collection Centre Jambusar women-run Milk Collection Centre (MCC), Madafar and Pachakada received AMCS system from Dudhdhara dairy. With this achievement there are now 4 MCCs which are digitalized. For rural women, operating a computer system is a sense of pride and boosts their confidence.









Employability-linked Skill Development

PI Foundation along with Rural Shores has been running a Skill Development Centre in Jambusar to impart vocational training across various trades to unemployed and underprivileged youth to generate employment for them after their course completion. Students got placement letters for jobs in the range of ₹7,000-11,000 salary.

OBJECTIVE

To improve livelihood of youth of underprivileged community.

Improving Learning Outcomes

PI Foundation in collaboration with Pratham Education Foundation has been implementing a CSR project to improve learning outcomes of underprivileged children in 135 elementary schools of 82 villages in Jambusar block of Bharuch district.

OBJECTIVE

- To plug the learning gaps in children and improve their foundational literacy & numeracy skills between Grades 1-8
- To build and improve scientific thinking of children & hone their application skills
- To strengthen and enhance support for community-level education
